- 1. Nowhere in Scripture is there a Command For Formal Church Membership
- 2. BUT Formal Church Membership is Implied
- 3. This Goes For Other Topics As Well
  - a. The Deity of Christ
  - b. The Trinity
  - c. The Rapture
- 4. Church Ekklesia = A Gathering, Assembly
  - a. Mentioned 114x in GNT
  - b. 90x Refers to Local Church
  - c. See 1 Cor 1.1-2, Gal 1.1-2, Eph 1.1, Acts 11.22, Rom 16.3-5
  - d. Picture: Local Churches Gathered Together

## 5. FIVE ways the Bible Implies a Formal Church Membership

- a. The Metaphors Used For the Church
  - i. Flock of God (Acts 20.28-30)
  - ii. A Holy Temple (**Eph 2.19-22**)
  - iii. Human Body (1 Cor 12.12-14)
  - iv. Household of God (1 Tim 3.14-15)
  - v. Demonstrate a Distinct Group apart from Everyone Else
- b. Use of the Phrase "gather the whole church" by Paul in 1 Corinthians 14.23
- c. Pastoral Oversight and Membership Obedience
  - i. Responsibilities of the Pastor
    - 1. Philp 1.1-2, Acts 20.28, 1 Tim 3. Titus 1
    - 2. Elders knew who was and was not part of the Church
    - 3. **Hebrews 13.17** Pastors are accountable for souls
  - ii. How can a pastor know without formal church membership?
- d. The word "join" (κολλασθαι) in Acts 5:12-13 means Strong Commitment
  - i. See also 1 Cor 6.16-17
- e. Redemptive Church Discipline
  - i. Matthew 18.15-17 and 1 Cor 5
  - ii. Redemptive, not Condemnatory:Church discipline is to win the man,not condemn him
  - iii. People are excommunicated for lack of repentance, not sin
  - iv. Redemptive Church Discipline Guards the Purity of the Bride of Christ
