Luke 3:21-22 – The Baptism of Jesus Christ, Part 2

Introduction: The Revelation of God

- 1. General Revelation: Creation (Proves God Exists)
- 2. Special Revelation: The Word of God
 - a. Reveals who God is, His character, purposes, decrees
 - b. Faithful preaching does not originate with man
 - c. Jesus made God known
- 3. The Message of Christ is God's Message: Faithful preachers proclaim Christ (1 Thess 2:4, Gal 1:11)
- 4. The Word of God has the Final Say: God's Word comes to us Miraculously (Prophets, Angels) and Provident Events
- 5. Popular Liberal Discreditation of Biblical Events Jesus as a Legend, Made up Stories
- 6. Human Witnesses Professed Jesus as Messiah
- 7. God Himself Testified Jesus as Messiah

Main Truth: Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God – He was a Man of Prayer, a Man of the Spirit. God testifies to God and God delights in God (God the Father Delights in God the Son).

Jesus' Prayerful Ascent at His Baptism (v 21a)

- 1. Confronting, Convicting, and Teaching!
 - a. Jesus constantly communicated with God in Prayer
 - i. Before He chose the 12, miraculously fed the 5k, walked on water, on the Mt. of Transfiguration
 - ii. He would escape the crowds and pray alone
 - b. If the Son of God was engaged in Prayer, how much more should we be engaged in prayer?
- 2. Jesus' Prayer was Communication with the Father (Heaven's War Room)
 - a. If prayer is not part of your life, Begin Today!
 - b. At Jesus' Baptism, He Prayed!
- 3. The Baptism of Jesus
 - a. Validated the Role of John as the Voice and Jesus as the Word Made Flesh
 - b. Identified Jesus as the Servant of Yahweh (Isaiah)
 - c. Jesus identified Himself with Sinful Humanity, even though Jesus did not Sin (**Hebrews 2:17**)
 - d. Inaugurated the Messianic Age and Jesus' public ministry (Luke 3:23)
 - e. Prefigured Jesus' death and resurrection (Mk 10:38)
 - f. Assisted in Jesus fulfilling all righteousness
- 4. Jesus was identified to be the Messiah by the Holy Spirit

The Heavens Rent, the Spirit's Descent (vv 21b-22a)

- 1. Heaven's Rent
 - a. Mark 1:10 Greek *Skidzo* meaning to rip or tear; Only other place in Mark this word is used is when the veil in the Holy of Holies is ripped from top to bottom (**Mark 15:38**)
 - b. God pulls back the curtains providing a glimpse into Heaven; He reveals something about Himself
 - i. Ex: Ezekiel (Ez 1:1), John (Rev 4:1), Stephen (Acts 7)
 - c. God says to us: Do you want to know who I am? I will show you... I will come down to you... and Be with you
 - d. At Jesus' Baptism, God was revealed to Israel
- 2. The Spirit's Descent: God testifies to God
 - a. God the Spirit testifies to God the Son
 - b. The Spirit Filled and Strengthened Jesus for Ministry and to battle the Satan (Luke 4)
 - c. Jesus was a Man of the Spirit (Isaiah 61:1-3)
 - d. Jesus was equipped to fulfill the Father's command
 - e. Jesus was Fully Man
 - i. Jesus got tired, thirsty, and was tempted as we do
 - ii. Jesus was everything it means to be human
 - iii. Jesus needed to be Human in order to identify with us
 - f. The Spirit consecrated Jesus, Anointed Him to make war on the Kingdom of Darkness (Luke 4:1-2a)
 - g. Jesus was strengthened by the Spirit: The flesh availeth nothing (**Zechariah 4:6**)
 - h. Jesus was filled by the Spirit to fulfill the Father's will; we too are to be filled with the Spirit (**Eph 5:18; Gal 5:16**)
 - i. Jesus was filled with the Spirit to fulfill all righteousness (Isaiah 11:1-2)

The Father's Assent: God Delights in God (v 22b)

- 1. God speaks from Heaven declaring Jesus is His Son
- 2. The only other time we see this happen is at the Mt of Transfiguration (**Luke 9:35**)
- 3. The Sonship of Jesus He is the Only Begotten Son of God
- 4. Our Sonship We are Adopted into the family of God
 - a. By nature we are children of wrath
 - b. We are made Children of God by Grace through Faith
- 5. Jesus is the Son of God by nature; Eternal God, sharing the very essence of what it means to be God
 - a. He shares in glory, divinity, and honor
- 6. The Father Delights in the Son: God delights in God
 - a. The Son delights in the Father (Isaiah 11:3)
 - b. Jesus is the exact representation of God's own nature
 - c. God exalts $\operatorname{Jesus} \operatorname{God}$ exalts God , God delights in God
